FRASERS HOSPITALITY TRUST - CORRIGENDUM TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS ANNOUNCEMENT, PRESS RELEASE AND FINANCIAL RESULTS PRESENTATION FOR THE FIRST HALF YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2021

Frasers Hospitality Asset Management Pte. Ltd., in its capacity as the manager of Frasers Hospitality Real Estate Investment Trust, and Frasers Hospitality Trust Management Pte. Ltd., in its capacity as the trustee-manager of Frasers Hospitality Business Trust wish to clarify that there was a typographical error in the percentage figure of "7.0%" mentioned in the following statement which appears on (i) page 16 of the financial statements announcement for the first half year ended 31 March 2021 ("1H FY2021") (the "Results Announcement"); (ii) page 3 of the press release on the financial results for 1H FY2021 (the "Press Release"); and (iii) slide 17 the financial results presentation for 1H FY2021 (the "Financial Results Presentation"), issued on 30 April 2021:

"The Federal Statistical Office of Germany reported that the number of overnight stays by domestic and foreign visitors for 2020 declined 39.0% yoy while for January and February of 2021, it fell yoy by 76.3% and 7.0% respectively."

The percentage figure of "7.0%" should be "76.0%" and the subject statement should read as follows:

"The Federal Statistical Office of Germany reported that the number of overnight stays by domestic and foreign visitors for 2020 declined 39.0% yoy while for January and February of 2021, it fell yoy by 76.3% and 76.0% respectively."

The change set out above has no material impact on the financial position of Frasers Hospitality Trust. All other information and figures in the Results Announcement, Press Release and Financial Results Presentation remain unchanged. The revised Results Announcement, Press Release and Financial Results Presentation incorporating the abovementioned change are enclosed.
